

ORDINANCE NO. 10-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL PROVIDING THAT THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO BE AMENDED BY REVISING SECTION 2-137 IN THE ROSWELL CITY CODE TO AMEND THE NUMBER OF CEMETERY BOARD MEMBERS FROM FIVE TO SEVEN; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND FIXING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Roswell City Code provides that the number of board members for the Cemetery Board of Roswell shall be five;

WHEREAS, the Roswell City Code has established criteria for all City Boards to have seven members;

WHEREAS, the Cemetery Board believes that a seven member Board will allow for better flexibility that will serve the Cemetery.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL, OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, that:

Section 1. The Roswell City Code, Section 2-137 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2-137. Membership

- a) A member of the City Council may be appointed by the Mayor to serve as an ex-officio member of the board. Other City personnel may be appointed or assigned as liaisons to the board by the City.
- b) Board members shall serve without compensation.
- c) The number of board members shall be seven. All other provisions of the City Code relating to boards and commissions shall apply to this board unless otherwise provided.

Section 2. Repealer. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent only of such conflict or inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any Ordinance or part of any Ordinance heretofore repealed.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance for any reason shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any other part of this Ordinance.


Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days following its publication.
