

ORDINANCE 18-04

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SEC. 2-96 OF THE ROSWELL CITY CODE
PERTAINING TO DEFINITIONS AND APPLICABILITY OF ORDINANCE
GOVERNING BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS**

Whereas, the City Council as the governing body of the City of Roswell, New Mexico wishes to utilize boards and commission in order to be more effective as a governing body; and

Whereas, each board or commission created may require specific operational considerations not presently accommodated by the present ordinance; and

Whereas, the City Council desires more flexibility when creating a board or commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL AS THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, that:

SECTION 1. Sec. 2-96 of the Roswell City Code shall be amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-96 – Definitions and Applicability.

Board shall mean any board, commission, task force, agency or any other body created by statute, ordinance, resolution or action of the mayor or governing body. The provisions of this Article shall apply to any Board unless otherwise specified in the Board's originating statute, ordinance, resolution, or action, as it may be amended.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or part of any ordinance heretofore repealed.

SECTION 3. If any section, paragraph, clause or provisions of this ordinance for any reason shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any other part of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be effective after five (5) days following its publication as required by law.
