

ORDINANCE NO. 282

An Ordinance Amending Section 1 of Ordinance 42 of the Compiled Ordinances of the City of Roswell.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL:

Section I.

That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 42 of the Compiled Ordinances of the City of Roswell entitled: "Scales and Weighing", passed January 27, 1914, be, and the same hereby is, amended so as to read as follows:

"Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation within the City of Roswell, New Mexico, to operate or maintain in any of the streets or avenues of said city within the district bounded on the west by Pennsylvania Avenue; on the east by Grand Avenue, on the south by Second Street and on the north by Fifth Street, all inclusive, any platform or other scales for the weighing of any commodity whatsoever; and all such scales now located, or being in or upon any of the streets or avenues in said city within the limits of the territory thus defined shall be removed by the owners thereof within thirty days from the passage and taking effect of this ordinance; and all holes or excavations left by such removals shall within like time be filled, tamped and water settled."

SECTION II.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after five days from its publication.
