ORDINANCE NO. 298

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 54 OF ORDINANCE NO. 33
OF THE COMPILED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL,
NEW MEXICO, THE SAME BEING AN ORDINANCE RELATING
TO MISDEMEANORS AND OFFENSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
ROSWELL:-

Section 1. That Section 54 of Ordinance No. 33 of the
Compiled Ordinances of the City of Roswell be, and the same
is hereby amended so as to read as follows:-

"Sec. 54. That no person, firm or corporation shall keep or maintain at his place of business or upon their premises within the following districts or limits in the City of Roswell, viz: From Ninth Street on the north to Albuquerque Street on the south, and from a line projected north and south from Ninth Street on the north to Albuquerque Street upon the east line of that street lying between Lots 9, 10, 11 and 12 and Lots 8 and 13 in Lea's Subdivision east of the railroad tracks and Grand Avenue, to Union Avenue on the west, any storage tank for oil, naphtha or gasoline, nor shall maintain any powder magazine for the keeping or storage of dynamite, gun-cotton, nitroglycerine or powder within the corporate limits of the City of Roswell.

There is hereby excluded from the limits above described, the south one-half of Block 4, South Roswell Addition to Roswell, and that on said south half of block 4, the Texas Oil Company, a corporation, organized under the laws of the State of Texas, is given permission to erect and maintain a warehouse and storage tanks in which to store and handle refined oils, gasoline, naphtha, lubricating and other oils and greases as are commonly carried in refined oil stations; with the understanding that all tanks and storage for oils shall be built on the SE $\frac{1}{4}$, provided the Texas Oil Company should elect to occupy said half block.


There is also hereby excluded from the limits above described, the following tract or parcel of land, to-wit:-

Part of Lots 1, 3, 5 and 7, of Block 3,
South Roswell, described as follows:-


Beginning at a point 100 feet south of the Northwest Corner of said Block 3; thence south along the West line of said Block 25 feet; thence east 100 feet; thence north 25 feet; thence west 100 feet to the point of beginning; said Lots and Block as shown on the official plat of South Roswell, on file in the office of the County Clerk of Chaves County, New Mexico, and that on said tract or parcel of land last described, the Roswell Auto Company, a Corporation organized under the laws of the State of New Mexico, is given permission to erect and maintain a warehouse and storage tanks in which to store and handle refined oils, gasoline, naphtha, lubricating and other oils and greases as are commonly carried in refined oil stations."

Section 2. That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication, as provided by Law.
