

ORDINANCE NO. 335.

AN ORDINANCE TO SUPPRESS GAMING AND GAMBLING HOUSES, LOTTERIES, AND FRAUDULENT DEVICES AND PRACTICES, AND FIXING A PENALTY FOR ITS VIOLATION.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Roswell:

Sec. 1. Hereafter it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation, or the agent of any such person, firm or corporation within the corporate limits of the City of Roswell, or within one mile thereof, to conduct, operate, or carry on any gaming or gambling house, or place or room for the purpose of gaining or obtaining money or property; or to knowingly lease, let or rent any house, room or place to another for such purpose, or to permit any person, firm or corporation, or the agent of any such person, firm or corporation to remain in such premises for such purpose after being notified that such person, firm or corporation, or the agent of such person, firm or corporation is violating the provisions of this ordinance, or to permit to be played any game such as monte, faro, passfaro, pass monte, vandeau, roulette, twenty-one, red and black, rouge et noir, poker, stud poker, craps, keno, or any other gambling game, or any game of chance played with cards, raffle or dice, or any subterfuge for the same by whatever name known; for any sum of money, or chips representing a money value, and any person, firm or corporation, or the agent thereof, who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance ~~shall be fined in a sum not less than \$50.00, nor more than \$300.00, or by imprisonment in the County or City Jail for not less than 30 days, nor more than 90 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court trying the case.~~ and upon conviction thereof before the proper Justice of the Peace or Police Judge shall be fined in a sum not less than \$50.00, nor more than \$300.00, or by imprisonment in the County or City Jail for not less than 30 days, nor more than 90 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court trying the case.

Sec. 2. That each day any of the provisions of this ordinance are violated shall constitute a separate offence.

Sec. 3. That this ordinance take effect five days after its publication according to law, and that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
