

ORDINANCE No. 349

An ordinance prohibiting the ^{placing upon or} burning of leaves, trash or any other kind of combustible material whatsoever, upon any of the paved portions of any street in the City of Roswell, New Mexico.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Roswell, New Mexico:

Sec. 1. That from and after the taking effect of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person to ^{place upon or} burn leaves, trash or any other kind of combustible material whatsoever, upon any of the paved portions of any street in the City of Roswell, New Mexico.

Sec. 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall be deemed guilty of an offence against the said City of Roswell, and upon conviction thereof before any court of competent jurisdiction, shall be fined in any sum not less than five dollars, nor more than twenty-five dollars, or be imprisoned for any period of time not less than one, nor more than thirty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court.

Sec. 3. That this ordinance take effect five days after its publication according to law, and that all ordinances, or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
