

ORDINANCE No. 363

An ordinance to amend section 49 of Ordinance Number 11 of the Compiled Ordinances of the City of Roswell.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Roswell, New Mexico:

Section 1. That Section 49 of Ordinance Number 11 of the Compiled Laws of the City of Roswell, New Mexico, be amended so as to provide that the fees of the Pound Keeper shall be as follows:

For each animal impounded	\$1.00
For each animal sold	.50
For the care, keeping and feeding of each horse, mule or neat cattle per day	\$1.00
For the care and keeping of each burro, <sup>sheep</sup> goat or hog, per day	.50

The Pound Master may also charge as additional expense the cost of advertising said cattle in the newspaper, when he deems the same advisable.

Section 2. That all ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in force from and after five days after its publication as required by law.
