

An ordinance amending Section fifty four of Ordinance No. 33 of the compiled ordinances of the City of Roswell, New Mexico.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Roswell, State of New Mexico.

SECTION No. 1: That there is hereby excluded from the limits first described in Section fifty four of Ordinance No. 33 of the compiled ordinance of the City of Roswell: the following portion of Block Three (3) to the City Addition of South Roswell: One hundred and five (105) feet facing West on Grand Avenue and two hundred feet (200)ft. facing North on Alameda Street.

And the Magnolia Petroleum Company, an unincorporated joint stock association, with its principal office in Galveston, Texas, is given permission to erect and maintain warehouses and storage tanks in which to store and handle refined oils, gasoline, naptha, lubricating, and other oils and greases such as are commonly carried and handled in refined oil stations.

Permission is also granted the Magnolia Petroleum Company to run underground pipe lines for unloading from cars under and across Grand Avenue from spur track of A. T. & S. F. R. R., now serving the Texas Company, to the storage tanks of said Magnolia Petroleum Company, located on the above described property.

SECTION No. 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after five days after its publication as provided by law.

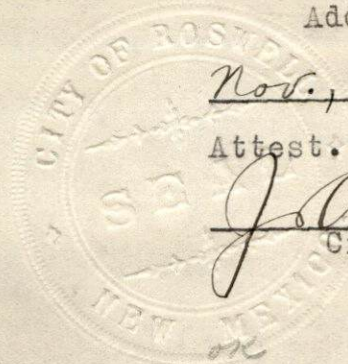
