ORDINANCE NO. 398

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE MOVING PICTURE SHOWS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for the owner, proprietor, manager or exhibitor of moving pictures to advertise, placard or exhibit in the City of Roswell any film, or any part thereof, which is obscene, indecent, immoral, inhuman or sacrilegious, or that is of such a character that the exhibition thereof would tend to corrupt morals or incite to crime.

Section 2. That any person, firm or corporation, who shall violate the provisions of Section 1 hereof, shall be fined for the first offense in a sum not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00); and for the second offense in a sum not to exceed Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00); and upon conviction for a second offense the license of such person, firm or corporation to exhibit moving pictures shall thereby be revoked.
