

ORDINANCE NO. 410

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION ONE OF ORDINANCE NO. 380, RELATIVE TO LICENSES OTHER THAN LIQUOR LICENSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL:

1. That Section one of Ordinance No. 380 be amended by adding thereto the following:

The above license fees are fixed upon the basis of the estimated average income from said occupations within the City of Roswell, upon a ratio of one dollar for each one thousand dollars of income, with a minimum license fee of five dollars per annum. For any occupation not hereinabove set out the license fee shall be five dollars per annum.

Any person desiring to contest the amount of said license upon said basis, may file an application for license with the city clerk under the provisions of section ten of ordinance number 24, and said license fee shall be fixed as provided by section nine of said ordinance number 24, upon the basis of one dollar for each thousand dollars income, and the city clerk shall issue same accordingly.
