

ORDINANCE NO. 416

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SALARIES OF  
CITY OFFICERS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
ROSWELL:

Section 1. That upon the appointment or election of any person to any salaried office in the City of Roswell, the City Council shall fix by resolution the salary to be received by said officer; the salaries of such officers as are for a definite term, not to be afterwards changed during the term for which such officers were appointed or elected; the salaries of such officers as may be appointed without term to be subject to be changed by resolution at any time the council may see fit.

Section 2. That unless otherwise fixed by resolution, at the time said officer is elected or appointed, such officer shall receive the same salary as has been paid to his predecessor until otherwise changed in accordance with the provisions hereof.

Section 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be, and the same are hereby repealed.
