

ORDINANCE NO. 420

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE SALE OF MEATS, POULTRY, FISH, BUTTER, CHEESE, VEGETABLES, AND ALL OTHER PROVISIONS, ^{including ice cream,} TO PROVIDE FOR THE PLACE AND MANNER OF SELLING THE SAME, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the health of the inhabitants of the City of Roswell to provide suitable sanitary regulation for the sale of the articles hereinafter provided; therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

Section . That no meats, poultry, fish, butter, cheese, lard, vegetables, or other provisions, ^{including ice cream,} shall be sold at any other place within the City of Roswell except in a building suitable for such purpose. Said building shall be properly screened from flies or other insects, and protected from dust and shall not be directly connected by door or other direct means of communication with any dwelling or sleeping apartment. Provided, However, that the above restrictions shall not be applied to prevent any person authorized by Chapter 67 of the 1919 Session Laws of New Mexico, being entitled, "An Act to Prohibit Incorporated Cities, Towns and Villages from collecting Occupation or other Taxes from Persons Selling Vegetables, Fruits, Meats and other Provisions of Their Own Raising", from selling the articles therein provided under the terms and in the manner therein set forth.

Section 2. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$100.00 for each offence, and each day's violation shall be

... separate offence, or confined in the city jail for not less than ten days nor more than thirty days for each offence, by the court trying the same, and each day's violation of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offence.

Section 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be, and the same are, hereby repealed.
