

ORDINANCE NO. 641

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN WEED AND GRASS GROWTHS TO BE A NUISANCE, REQUIRING THE OWNER, LESSEE, OCCUPANT, AGENT, SERVANT OR EMPLOYEE THEREOF TO CUT AND REMOVE SAME, PROVIDING FOR PUBLIC SANITATION, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL:

SECTION I.

ANY OWNER, lessee, or occupant, or agent, servant, representative, or employee of such owner, lessee, or occupant, having control of any lot of ground, or any part of any lot, within the City of Roswell, who shall allow or maintain on any such lot any growth of weeds to a height of over one foot, shall be deemed maintaining a nuisance. Provided, that this shall not be construed to cover alfalfa or other farm or garden products, yard shrubbery, etc.


SECTION II.

WHENEVER ANY NUISANCE or growth of weeds herein prohibited shall be found to exist on private property within the City of Roswell, the City Marshal shall order in writing the owner, lessee, or occupant, or the person or persons who permit such nuisance to exist, to cut and remove the same within five days after the service of said notice upon them, and any person who shall fail or refuse to obey such order shall be deemed to have violated the provisions of this Section, and each day such weeds shall remain, after said five days notice, shall be held and deemed to be a separate offense.

SECTION III.

ALL ORDINANCES and parts of Ordinances in conflict
herewith are hereby repealed.
