ORDINANCE NO. 671

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF DOGS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, AND PROVIDING FOR THE POUNDING OF DOGS FOUND ON THE STREETS AND IN OTHER PUBLIC PLACES: AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for any person owning or keeping a dog within the corporate limits of the City of Roswell to permit said dog to be at large upon the streets and alleys or other public places or public grounds in said City, or upon the private property of another person.

Section 2: It shall be the duty of the city pound keeper to take up and impound all dogs found at large contrary to the preceding section and to make disposition of such dogs in accordance with ordinances of this City now in effect.

Section 3: Any person found guilty of violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be punished by a fine not exceeding three hundred dollars, or by imprisonment not exceeding ninety days, or both such fine and imprisonment.
