

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING BY REFERENCE, THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, POSITION CLASSIFICATION PLAN AND SALARY RANGE PLAN, SCHEDULE II, THERETO, AND REPEALING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the City of Roswell adopt a fixed Position Classification Plan, together with a Salary Range Plan (Schedule II), for carrying the same into effect; and

WHEREAS, said Position Classification Plan, together with said Salary Range Plan (Schedule II) thereto are on file in the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Roswell, New Mexico, that said plans are hereby expressly referred to, and that the provisions therein contained should be adopted by reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

1. That the Position Classification Plan, City of Roswell, New Mexico, 1956, is hereby referred to, made a part of this Ordinance, in manner and form, as though said Classification Plan and Salary Range Plan thereto, be set forth in full in this Ordinance.


2. That a copy of said Plans shall at all reasonable times, be available and subject to inspection at the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Roswell, in the City Hall.

3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure on the grounds of urgent public need and therefore, upon its final passage and adoption, shall forthwith be recorded in the book of Ordinances of said City, kept for that purpose, authenticated by the signatures of the Mayor and the City Clerk of said City and shall be published in the Roswell Daily Record, and shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after such publication.
