

ORDINANCE NO. 803

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 738 OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL: FIXING THE SALARY OF THE MUNICIPAL JUDGE: REPEALING SECTION 1 OF SAID ORDINANCE, TOGETHER WITH ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS OR PARTS THEREOF, INCONSISTENT HEREWITH AND, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Roswell heretofore by its Motion duly adopted and approved has fixed the salary of the office of Judge of the Municipal Court of said City in the sum of \$440.00 per month.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 738 of said City be, and the same hereby is, amended to read as follows, to-wit:

1. That the salary of the office of Municipal Judge of the City of Roswell, which shall be paid to such Municipal Judge as shall be duly elected and qualified to that office and, to his lawful successors, shall be the sum of \$440.00 per month.


2. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 738 together with all other ordinances and resolutions or parts thereof, inconsistent herewith be, and the same hereby are repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or parts of any ordinance heretofore repealed.

3. That this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Roswell, Chaves County, New Mexico, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure on the ground of urgent public need; and therefore, immediately upon its final passage, shall be recorded in the book of ordinances of said City kept for that purpose, authenticated by the signatures of the Mayor and City Clerk, shall be published in the Roswell Daily Record, a legal newspaper published and of general circulation in said City, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect five days after such publication.


