

ORDINANCE NO. 821

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6-4 OF ARTICLE I OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO 1962 BY MAKING CERTAIN ADDITIONS THERETO AND, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

1. That Section 604, Article I of the Code of the City of Roswell, New Mexico 1962 be, and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto the following:

Upon receipt by the City of notice from the Chief of the division of liquor control of the State Bureau of Revenue of application made and filed requesting issuance of a new license as a retailer, dispenser or club within the city or, requesting transfer of ownership, change of location or place of use of any such license, the City Clerk of said City shall publish notice of the time and place of public hearing to be held before the City Council, as the Council shall direct, all in accordance with Chapter 263 of the 1963 Session Laws of the State of New Mexico in such case made and provided.


2. That any such applicant as above set forth shall pay to the City Clerk of said City a sum equal to the costs of any such publication so made by said City as reimbursement for costs of publication therein expended.


3. That this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Roswell, Chaves County, New Mexico, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure on the ground of urgent public need; and therefore, immediately upon its final passage, shall be recorded in the book of ordinances of said City kept for that purpose, authenticated by the signatures of the Mayor and City Clerk, shall be published in the Roswell Dailey Record, a legal newspaper, published and of general circulation in said City, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect five days after such publication.
