

ORDINANCE NO. 838

FOR PUBLICATION ONE TIME ON 9 JULY 1964

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 21-6
OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL,
NEW MEXICO 1962 AND, DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL,
NEW MEXICO:

1. That Section 21-6 of the Code of the City of Roswell, New Mexico 1962 be, and the same hereby is amended to read as follows, to-wit:-

"Sec. 21-6. Temporary incapacity, temporary substitute.

. In the event of the temporary incapacity or temporary absence of the duly elected municipal judge, the Mayor of the city is hereby authorized and empowered to nominate and appoint an attorney or justice of the peace of the county sitting within the city, to sit for the municipal judge during the temporary incapacity or absence of the municipal judge. Such attorney or justice of the peace so appointed shall have jurisdiction to hear and determine cases arising from violations of the city code and other city ordinances while sitting as municipal judge during such incapacity or absence of the municipal judge."

2. That this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Roswell, Chaves County, New Mexico, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure on the ground of urgent public need; and therefore, immediately upon its final passage, shall be recorded in the book of ordinances of said City kept for that purpose, authenticated by the signatures of the Mayor and City Clerk, shall be published in the Roswell Daily Record, a legal newspaper, published and of general circulation in said City, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect five days after such publication.
