

ORDINANCE NO. 858

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 116, CHAPTER 20, DIVISION 2 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO 1962, ENTITLED PARKING METERS AND, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

1. That Section 116, Chapter 20, Division 2 of the Code of the City of Roswell, New Mexico 1962 be, and the same hereby is amended to read as follows, to-wit:

Section 20-116. Time of operation of meters.

The provisions of this division shall apply to vehicles parked or standing upon the streets of the city in parking meter zones when such vehicles are parked or standing on such streets between the hours of 8:00 A. M. until 6:00 P. M. on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays, and between the hours of 8:00 A. M. and 6:00 P. M. on Saturdays, except as shall be otherwise provided by the City Council. The provisions of this division shall not apply from 6:00 P. M. until 8:00 A. M. the following morning on each of the week days, except between the hours of 6:00 P. M. on Saturday until 8:00 A. M. on Mondays and on legal holidays, unless it shall be otherwise provided by posted notice within such marked and/or restricted parking area, stating the hours of each day and the specific days of the week when each of such time limited parking meters shall be and remain operative. The provisions of this section are neither intended nor to be construed in such manner as to amend or vacate any of the provisions of this code or other ordinances of the city relating to the parking of vehicles on the streets of the city after midnight.

2. That this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Roswell, Chaves County, New Mexico, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure on the ground of urgent public need; and therefore, immediately upon its final passage, shall be recorded in the book of ordinances of said City kept for that purpose, authenticated by the signatures of the Mayor and the City Clerk, shall be published in the Roswell Daily Record, a legal newspaper published and of general circulation in said City, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect five days after such publication.
