

ORDINANCE NO. 882

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 136, CHAPTER 20 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO 1962, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT OR INCONSISTENT HEREWITH AND, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

1. Section 136, Chapter 20 of the Code of the City of Roswell, New Mexico be, and the same hereby is amended to read as follows, to-wit:

Sec. 20-136. Immediate notice of accidents.

The driver of a vehicle involved in an accident within the city resulting in injury to or death of any person or property damage to an apparent extent of one hundred (\$100.00) dollars or more shall immediately, by the quickest means of communication, give notice of such accident to the city police department. (Chap. 12, 1967 Laws of New Mexico)

2. CONFLICTING ORDINANCES REPEALED.

That all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or parts of any ordinance heretofore repealed.

3. EMERGENCY.

That this Ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Roswell, Chaves County, New Mexico, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure on the ground of urgent public need; and therefore, immediately upon its final passage, shall be recorded in the book of ordinances of said City kept for that purpose, authenticated by the signatures of the Mayor and the City Clerk, shall be published in the Roswell Daily Record, a legal newspaper published and of general circulation in said City, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five days after such publication.
