

ORDINANCE NO. 887

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBSECTION 11 OF SECTION 1, ARTICLE XVI OF ORDINANCE NO. 807; REPEALING PARAGRAPH 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 867; REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT OR INCONSISTENT HEREWITH AND, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

1. That Subsection 11 of Section 1, Article XVI of Ordinance No. 807 be, and the same hereby is, amended to read as follows, to-wit:

11. A front yard of not less than ten (10) feet shall be provided in those parts of the "D" Commercial Districts and "F" Industrial Districts, fronting upon Second Street, where the right of way is less than one hundred (100) feet in width. "

2. That Paragraph 2 of Ordinance No. 867, amending Subsection 11 of Section 1, Article XVI of Ordinance No. 807 as follows:

11. (a) Any provision or provisions in this ordinance to the contrary notwithstanding, any structure or structures abutting upon Second Street shall maintain a setback of not less than ten (10) feet from the street right of way on Second Street where such right of way is less than one hundred (100) feet in width.


be, and the same hereby is repealed.

3. That all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or parts of any ordinance heretofore repealed.

4. That this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace, safety, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Roswell, Chaves County, New Mexico, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure on the ground of urgent public need; and therefore, immediately upon its final passage, shall be recorded in the book of ordinances of said City kept for that purpose, authenticated by the signatures of the Mayor and the City Clerk, shall be published in the Roswell Daily Record, a legal newspaper published and of general circulation in said City, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect five days after such publication.
