ORDINANCE NO. 924

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR COMPENSATION FOR THE MAYOR AND MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL EFFECTIVE UPON THEIR ELECTION TO OFFICE ON AND AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE, PURSUANT TO 14-9-3, NMS 1953 AS AMENDED BY CHAPTER 149, LAWS 1971 AND DECLARING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

1. That the Mayor of the City of Roswell be paid compensation for his services to the municipality in an amount computed upon a pro-rata monthly payment equal to, but not to exceed in its aggregate, the amount of the annual compensation paid to a member of the Board of County Commissioners of Chaves County, New Mexico.


2. That the Mayor Pro-Tem (President of the City Council) be paid compensation for his services to the municipality in an amount computed upon a pro-rata monthly payment equal to, but not to exceed in its annual aggregate, one-half (fifty per centum) of the annual compensation paid to a member of the Board of County Commissioners of Chaves County, New Mexico.

3. That councilmen, members of the city governing body, who shall be elected to office at the regular municipal election for office to be held on March 7, 1972, and those elected or appointed thereafter, be paid compensation for their services to the municipality in an amount computed upon a pro-rata monthly payment equal to, but not to exceed in its annual aggregate, one-fourth (25 per centum) of the amount of the annual compensation paid to a member of the Board of County Commissioners of Chaves County, New Mexico, except that any appointee for an unexpired term, expiring in 1974, shall not be paid compensation for any part or portion of said unexpired term.

4. This ordinance shall be and become effective on and after March 1, 1972.
