

ORDINANCE NO. 996

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL ANNEXING PORTIONS OF LOTS 23 AND 30, MILITARY HEIGHTS ADDITION, IN CHAVES COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, TO THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, AND FIXING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, a Petition has heretofore been filed seeking annexation of certain real property to the City of Roswell; and

WHEREAS, said Petition has been signed by the president of the Board of Regents of the New Mexico Military Institute, and by the president and secretary of the New Mexico Military Institute Foundation Inc., being the owners of said real property; and,

WHEREAS, said lands are contiguous to the boundary and corporate limite of the City of Roswell; and,

WHEREAS, said Petition is accompanied by a map showing the territory to be annexed, which map is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and,

WHEREAS, the Governing Body, the City Council, of the City of Roswell, in Chaves County, New Mexico has consented to the annexation of said real property in regular public meeting, all in accordance with Sec. 14-7-17 (NMSA, 1953).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL, OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

1. That the City of Roswell does hereby annex the following described real property located within Chaves County, New Mexico:

The West 190 feet of the East 390 feet of Lot 30 and the West 190 feet of the East 390 feet of the South 92.45 feet of Lot 23, Military Heights Addition as shown by the official plat thereof on file in the office of the County Clerk of Chaves County, New Mexico.


