ORDINANCE NO. 1001

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO CREATING A NEW SEC. 27-9 OF THE CITY CODE, CHANGING THE NUMERICAL LIMITATION ON MEMBERSHIP IN THE POLICE AUXILIARY, PROVIDING FOR REPEAL, AND FIXING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL, OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, that,

Section 1. Repeal. Section 27-9 of the Roswell City Code is hereby repealed.

Section 2. New Section. A new Section 27-9 of the Roswell City Code is hereby ordained, as follows:


There is hereby created a city police auxiliary or reserve corps, hereinafter called "corps", which shall be a voluntary organization composed of volunteer members to serve without compensation, appointed by the mayor and confirmed by the city council upon recommendation of the chief of police pursuant to the provisions of this article. The police auxiliary corps shall be limited to fifty (50) persons.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective on and after June 1, 1977.


