ORDINANCE NO. 1039

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE 1979 EDITION OF THE NEW MEXICO UNIFORM TRAFFIC ORDINANCE AS PROMULGATED BY THE TRAFFIC SAFETY BUREAU OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE DIVISION, NEW MEXICO STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT HERewith; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND FIXING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, certain changes in the state traffic code have necessitated corresponding revisions in municipal traffic codes, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council of Roswell, New Mexico to adopt the 1979 New Mexico Uniform Traffic Ordinance, as an ordinance of this City,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL, OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. The 1979 New Mexico Uniform Traffic Ordinance, as promulgated by the Traffic Safety Bureau, Motor Vehicle Division, New Mexico Department of Transportation is hereby adopted in its entirety as the traffic code of the City of Roswell.

Section 2. Repealer. All ordinances, parts of ordinances or fee schedules in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or part of any ordinance heretofore repealed.

Section 3. Severability. That if any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this ordinance for any reason shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause, or provision shall not affect any other part of this ordinance.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be and become effective five days after its publication.
