

ORDINANCE NO. 1096


AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING BRASHER ROAD PAVING DISTRICT NO. 1982-1 FROM MAIN STREET TO SUNSET AVENUE AND ADOPTING THE ASSESSMENT PLAT, PRELIMINARY PLANS, AND ESTIMATES OF COST, AND ORDERING THE IMPROVEMENTS TO BE CONSTRUCTED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO that:

1. The City Council, after a Public Hearing on Brasher Road Paving District No. 1982-1 and after considering all public input and comments, hereby establishes the above paving district and further orders that the assessments against abutting property owners contained in Attachment D are hereby adopted.
2. The final assessment against each tract or parcel in the above paving district will be established at the time the improvements are completed and those assessed shall have the opportunity to pay the entire assessment within thirty (30) days of the notice of final assessment. After thirty (30) days the assessment will be subject to a three (3) year deferred payment plan at an interest rate of six (6%) percent per annum with payments due yearly.
3. Any assessment not paid within the three (3) years including interest will constitute a lien against the property.
4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or parts of any ordinance heretofore repealed.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO THAT:

1. The City Council, after a Public Hearing on Brasher Road Paving District No. 1982-1 and after considering all public input and comments, hereby establishes the above paving district and further orders that the assessments against abutting property owners contained in Attachment D are hereby adopted.

2. The final assessment against each tract or parcel in the above paving district will be established at the time the improvements are completed and those assessed shall have the opportunity to pay the entire assessment within thirty (30) days of the notice of final assessment. After thirty (30) days the assessment will be subject to a three (3) year deferred payment plan at an interest rate of six (6%) percent per annum with payments due yearly.

3. Any assessment not paid within the three (3) years including interest will constitute a lien against the property.

4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or parts of any ordinance heretofore repealed.
