

ORDINANCE NO. 1199

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL AMENDING SECTION 2-66 OF THE ROSWELL CITY CODE TO PERMIT COMBINATION OR SEPARATION OF THE OFFICES OF CITY CLERK AND CITY TREASURER; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND FIXING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to make provision for combining or separating the offices of City Clerk and City Treasurer as may from time to time be desirable, and

WHEREAS, the existing provisions of the Roswell City Code provide only for a combined office;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL, OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. In the Roswell City Code, 1984, Section 2-66 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-66. Offices Combined.

The offices of City Clerk and City Treasurer may be combined and one person appointed to fill the combined office. Such person shall be referred to in this Code as the "Clerk-Treasurer". Should the offices not be combined, the City Treasurer shall be appointed as a Deputy City Clerk and shall conduct all fiscal matters assigned by law to the City Clerk. Duties of the separate offices shall be as specified herein and the required bond shall be executed for each office. All powers and duties now imposed by the legislative acts and ordinances of the City shall not be affected and shall be in full force and effect as to the powers and duties of the person(s) appointed to fill such office(s).


Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or part of any ordinance heretofore repealed.

Section 3. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance for any reason shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any other part of this ordinance.


Section 4. This ordinance shall be and become effective on and after five (5) days following its publication as required by law.
