

ORDINANCE NO. 1236

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL AMENDING SECTION 3-21 IN THE ROSWELL CITY CODE TO PROVIDE A NEW ANNUAL LICENSE FEE OF \$250 UPON THE PRIVILEGE OF THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND FIXING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, selling alcoholic beverages within the city contributes to the demand for city services, and

WHEREAS, the city is authorized to impose an annual liquor license tax upon the privilege of the selling of alcoholic beverages within the city, and

WHEREAS, the amount of such annual fee shall not exceed \$250.00,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL, OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, that:

Section 1. In the Roswell City Code Section 3-21 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 3-21. Imposed; amount.

There are hereby imposed annual liquor license taxes upon the privilege of the sale of alcoholic beverages within the city, as shall be duly licensed by the state department of alcoholic beverage control or other authorized instrumentality as follows:

Retailers license	\$250.00
Dispensers license	250.00
Canopy license	250.00
Club license	250.00
Restaurant license (beer & wine)	250.00

Section 2. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent only of such conflict or inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or part of any ordinance heretofore repealed.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance for any reason shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any other part of this ordinance.


Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective five days following its publication as provided by law.
