

ORDINANCE NO. 1243

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL REPEALING SECTION 14-48 IN THE ROSWELL CITY CODE, RELATING TO REGULATION OF ITINERANT AUCTIONEERS; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND FIXING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the ten dollar fee imposed upon auctions within the City constitutes a burden on enterprise, and

WHEREAS, there appears no present necessity for continuing to assess a specific charge against auctions whether conducted at a fixed location or at various locations, and

WHEREAS, it appears the citizens of the community will not be put at risk by abandoning the present charge for auction sales,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL, OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, that:

Section 1. Section 14-48 of the Roswell City Code, 1984, is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent only of such conflict or inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or part of any ordinance heretofore repealed.


Section 3. Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance for any reason shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any other part of this ordinance.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective five days following its publication as provided by law.


