RESOLUTION NO. 02-16

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DONATION OF FOUR EMERGENCY WARNING SIRENS TO THE TOWN OF DEXTER, NEW MEXICO A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION.

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell, New Mexico has replaced its fifty year old emergency warning siren system with up to date emergency warning sirens.

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell does not have further use of the four sirens.

WHEREAS, the sirens are obsolete for the City of Roswell's purposes, parts are no longer being manufactured and two were operable when replaced.

WHEREAS, the estimated value of the four sirens is less than two hundred dollars.

WHEREAS, under the authority of 3--54-2 NMSA 1978, one political subdivision may exchange or donate real or personal property to another political subdivision.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Roswell, New Mexico, finds that it would be in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Roswell and the Town of Dexter to provide the Town of Dexter a means of warning its citizens of impending disasters.


