

RESOLUTION NO. 03-01

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING IMPLEMENTATION OF A \$4.50
PASSENGER FACILITY CHARGE AT ROSWELL INDUSTRIAL AIR CENTER**

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell operates, maintains and develops the Airport, in part, with federal grants, user fees, passenger facility charges and other local funds; and

WHEREAS, a \$4.50 Passenger Facility Charge (PFC) is now authorized by Federal Law and this user fee is imposed only on eligible enplaned passengers utilizing the Airport; and

WHEREAS, The City of Roswell, New Mexico, has in the past used a \$3.00 PFC to fund capital projects; and

WHEREAS, the Airport Committee, after thorough investigation, has recommended to the City Council that the funds generated by increasing the PFC level to \$4.50 are needed to accomplish projects designed to enhance security, capacity, safety and development of the Roswell Industrial Air Center; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Roswell, New Mexico, that the City Manager is authorized to file a new application and any necessary amendments to the existing application with the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), authorizing the continuation of the imposition of a PFC at the increased level of \$4.50, and the expenditure of revenues from the PFC at Roswell Industrial Air Center, in accordance with the Capital Development Program, and the assurances and understandings contained in the applications.


