RESOLUTION NO. 04-05

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 03-46 AND PROVIDING FOR THE FURTHER STUDY OF THE TRAFFIC CONDITIONS IN THE AREA OF NORTH MONTANA BETWEEN FOURTH STREET AND RIVERSIDE

WHEREAS, the City Council has earlier adopted Resolution No. 03-46 and thereby effected closure of North Montana between Fourth Street and Riverside, and

WHEREAS, the above closure of Montana has been monitored and found to reduce traffic volumes and speeds in the area of the closure, and

WHEREAS, the lowered traffic volume and traffic speed are considered to have improved public safety in the area and to have enhanced the neighborhood, and

WHEREAS, other traffic controls have been considered but not yet evaluated,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL, OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO that: the City Engineer be allowed to perform such further investigations of traffic conditions in the area of North Montana between Fourth Street and Montana as he deems appropriate and thereafter report the results of his investigations. Further, be it resolved that in order to facilitate the City Engineer's investigations Resolution No. 03-46 should be and hereby is amended to provide the City Engineer may reopen the closed roadway to properly investigate traffic conditions for a period not to exceed six (6) months from the date of this resolution.
