**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO FILE A PROGRAM
GRANT APPLICATION FOR 2005 / 2006 NEW MEXICO MAIN STREET
PROGRAM FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL'S ARTS IN
PUBLIC PLACES INITIATIVE**

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell desires to make application to the State of New Mexico Main Street Program for consideration in the 2005 / 2006 Main Street Grant Program, and

WHEREAS, Mayor Bill B. Owen is the Chief Local Elected Official of the City of Roswell; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Roswell adopted a Public Arts Policy, dated December 2003, supporting art in public places; and

WHEREAS, the Spring River Corridor Foundation has requested the City's support in placing a bronze statuary, by artist Glenna Goodacre, on the northeast corner of the Brainerd Plaza at the Convention and Civic Center, located at 912 North Main Street; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Roswell, authorizes an appraisal on the proposed site, thereby, establishing current market value and that the appraised value be used as the basis for an in-kind contribution for the sole purpose of placing a bronze statuary as referenced herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the governing body, the City Council of Roswell, New Mexico:

That the Mayor is, and hereby authorized to submit an application requesting program funds on behalf of the City of Roswell and to perform any and all such other acts, matters and manner of things as shall be and become necessary and proper to effectuate the purposes herein.


