

**RESOLUTION 05-34
ELECTION RESOLUTION**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, that:

A. A regular municipal election for the election of municipal officers shall be held on March 7, 2006. Polls will open at 7:00 a.m. and close at 7:00 p.m.

B. At the regular municipal election, persons shall be elected to fill the following elective offices:

- One Mayor for a four year term.
- One Councilor from Ward 1 for a four year term.
- One Councilor from Ward 2 for a four year term.
- One Councilor from Ward 3 for a four year term.
- One Councilor from Ward 4 for a four year term.
- One Councilor from Ward 5 for a four year term.
- One Municipal Judge for a four year term.

C. The following locations are designated as polling places for the conduct of the regular municipal elections:

D. **ABSENTEE VOTING.** (By Mail) Any qualified elector of the City of Roswell shall obtain his or her application for an absentee ballot, only from the office of the Municipal Clerk. All applications for an absentee ballot must be completed and accepted by the Municipal Clerk prior to 5:00 p.m., March 3, 2006. After 5:00 p.m. on March 3, 2006, all unused absentee ballots will be publicly destroyed by the Municipal Clerk. The

Municipal Clerk will accept completed absentee ballots delivered by mail, or in person by the voter casting the absentee ballot, until 7:00 p.m. on March 7, 2006.

Absentee voting by machine will be conducted in the office of the Municipal Clerk, during regular hours and days of business, Monday through Friday, beginning on Wednesday, February 15, 2006 and closing at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 3, 2006.

E. Persons desiring to register to vote at the regular municipal election, must register with the Chaves County Clerk not later than Tuesday, February 7, 2006 at 5:00 p.m., the date on which the County Clerk will close registration books.

F. All Declarations of Candidacy shall be filed with the Municipal Clerk on Tuesday, January 10, 2006 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
