A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO
NOTIFYING THE NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION THAT THE CITY
OF ROSWELL SUPPORTS AND HAS THE REQUIRED FUNDING FOR THE COOPERATIVE
AGREEMENT PROGRAM FOR TRAFFIC SIGNAL IMPROVEMENTS AT THE
INTERSECTION OF WEST McGAFFEY STREET AND SOUTH UNION AVENUE.

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell desires to improve the traffic signal equipment
at the intersection of West McGaffey Street and South Union Avenue, and

WHEREAS, this roadway is eligible for New Mexico Department of Transportation
(NMDOT) Cooperative Agreement (CO-OP) funds, and


WHEREAS, the preliminary cost estimate for the traffic signal improvements is
\$152,878.91 and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell desires to utilize NMDOT CO-OP funds for the traffic
signal improvements.

the City Council of the City of Roswell, New Mexico that:

1. The City of Roswell fully supports and adopts the proposed project for traffic signal
improvements to the intersection of West McGaffey Street and South Union Avenue.

improvements.
3. The City of Roswell has placed this project as a high priority and will meet or exceed
all required deadlines.
