

RESOLUTION NO. 7-16

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FROM THE NEW MEXICO FINANCE AUTHORITY FOR AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN AVIATION CENTER COMPLEX.

WHEREAS, in an effort to support economic development in the City of Roswell, Chaves County, and the region the Aviation Center Complex would have three main economic components. First, the ENMU-Roswell National Flight Test Center which will align with the existing Flight Research Training Center; second, the Interactive Learning Center which would align with the existing ENMU-Roswell Aviation Maintenance Technology Center; third, the Walker Aviation Museum. The vision of the Aviation Center Complex is to plan, develop, and promote the growth of the center and enhance economic development for the entire region; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell desires to apply for an economic development feasibility study in the amount of \$50,000 for the proposed Aviation Center Complex at the Roswell International Air Center; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Finance Authority requires the Governing Body to authorize the Mayor to make application on behalf of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body, the City Council of the City of Roswell, that the City be authorized to apply for the economic development feasibility study from the New Mexico Finance Authority in the amount of \$50,000. It is further resolved that the Mayor be authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effect such application.
