

RESOLUTION NO. 07-34

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING IMPLEMENTATION OF A \$4.50
PASSENGER FACILITY CHARGE AT THE ROSWELL INTERNATIONAL AIR
CENTER**

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell operates, maintains and develops the Airport, in part, with federal grants, user fees, passenger facility charges and other local funds; and

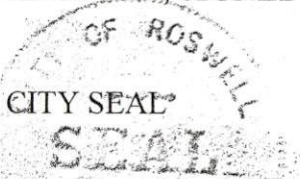
WHEREAS, a \$4.50 Passenger Facility Charge (PFC) is now authorized by Federal Law and this user fee is imposed only on eligible enplaned passengers utilizing the Airport; and

WHEREAS, The City of Roswell, New Mexico, has in the past used a \$4.50 PFC to fund capital projects; and

WHEREAS, the Airport Committee, after thorough investigation, has recommended to the City Council that the funds generated by the PFC fee of \$4.50 are needed to accomplish projects designed to enhance security, capacity, safety and development of the Roswell International Air Center, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Roswell, New Mexico, that the City Manager is authorized to file a new application and any necessary amendments to the existing application with the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), authorizing the continuation of the imposition of a PFC fee of \$4.50, and the expenditure of revenues from the PFC at the Roswell International Air Center, in accordance with the Capital Development Program, and the assurances and understandings contained in the applications.
