

RESOLUTION NO. 08-41

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO NOTIFYING THE CHAVES COUNTY COMMISSION, THE CITIZENS OF CHAVES COUNTY, AND THE CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL THAT THE CITY OF ROSWELL SUPPORTS THE FEASIBILITY STUDY OF THE EAST RELIEF ROUTE.

WHEREAS, traffic volume through the City of Roswell has reached levels that impair local utilization of Main Street through the City, and

WHEREAS, it appears an alternate, relief route outside of the City would be an effective means to address the present traffic problems and an effective means to assure adequate traffic routing for the future, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Roswell has previously announced its support for the study of a possible relief route located to the east of Roswell, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Roswell has budgeted \$150,000 with the intent it be available to assist in studying an east relief route should Chaves County elect to undertake such a relief route study, and

WHEREAS, the relief route study is considered essential under the City's master plan,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED AND DECLARED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL, OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO THAT: the City of Roswell supports undertaking a study of the possible relief route and its benefit to the City and the City affirms it has budgeted for up to \$150,000 to be available for the City's participation in the funding of such study.
