RESOLUTION NO. 09-28 OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A NEW MEXICO COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION/LOCAL GOVERNMENT DIVISION; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACT AS THE CITY'S CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY OF ROSWELL'S PARTICIPATION IN THE 2010 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) APPLICATION.

WHEREAS, the need exists within the City of Roswell for neighborhood improvement projects in several low and moderate income neighborhoods, and the City of Roswell desires to apply to the Housing and Urban Development's Community Development Block Grant Program to obtain funding for neighborhood improvements projects; and

WHEREAS, the City held a public hearing, Tuesday, September 8, 2009, providing the public the opportunity for input and comment regarding the 2010 application process; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that there is a significant need to undertake a CDBG project to provide adequate services to the community; and

WHEREAS, the City Council determines that the Working Mother's Day Nursery project meets the requirements of the Community Development Block Grant Program.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, that

1. The City of Roswell is hereby authorized to prepare and submit a Community Development Block Grant Application to the New Mexico Department of Finance and Administration/Local Government Division for the Working Mother's Day Nursery project;
2. That the City Council directs and designates the Mayor as the City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the City of Roswell's participation in the New Mexico Community Development Block Grant Program.
3. The City of Roswell officials and staff are directed to do any and all acts necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution.
4. That the application for \$500,000.00 of grant funds to carry out the Working Mother's Day Nursery project;
5. That it further be stated that the Roswell City Council is committing \$50,000 from its General Fund as a cash match contribution toward the CDBG project activities.
