

RESOLUTION NO. 10-46

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MAIN STREET AND THE DIVERSION OF TRAFFIC DURING THE EASTERN NEW MEXICO STATE FAIR PARADE.

WHEREAS, the Eastern New Mexico State Fair begins its festivities each year with a parade down Main Street (U.S. Highway 285) starting at College Boulevard and continuing South to Reed Street; and

WHEREAS, the parade attracts thousands of spectators and participants each year, many of whom are the youth of Roswell and surrounding communities, facilitated by the closure of schools during "parade day"; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the safety and protection of those persons taking part in the parade or watching the parade that vehicular traffic on Main Street between 19th Street and McGaffey Street be temporarily closed and diverted according to a plan formulated between Eastern New Mexico State Fair, the City of Roswell, the New Mexico Department of Transportation, and the Roswell Police Department; and


WHEREAS, the parade requires said temporary closure between 9:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m., which will not pose an undue burden on the vehicular traffic diverted when weighed against the safety issues referenced immediately above.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO that: Main Street (U.S. Highway 285) be temporarily closed between 19th Street and McGaffey Street each year that the Eastern New Mexico Fair Parade takes place, beginning October 4, 2010, between 9:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. and that traffic be diverted according to such plan as may be approved by applicable authority.


