**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO
NOTIFYING THE NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION THAT THE CITY
OF ROSWELL SUPPORTS AND HAS THE REQUIRED FUNDING FOR THE COOPERATIVE
AGREEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE INSTALLATION OF SIDEWALKS, DRIVE PADS AND
ADA IMPROVEMENTS ON SOUTH GARDEN AVENUE FROM EAST SECOND STREET TO
EAST WALNUT STREET.**

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell desires to improve this section of South Garden Avenue for pedestrian movements and ADA access, and

WHEREAS, this project is eligible for New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) Cooperative Agreement (CO-OP) funds, and



WHEREAS, the preliminary cost estimate for the project improvements is \$100,014.58, including gross receipts tax, and


WHEREAS, the City of Roswell desires to utilize NMDOT CO-OP funds in the amount of \$75,010.94 for the project improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND DECLARED by the Governing Body, the City Council of the City of Roswell, New Mexico that:

- 1. The City of Roswell fully supports and adopts the proposed project for the installation of sidewalks, drive pads, and ADA improvements on South Garden Avenue from East Second Street to East Walnut Street.**
- 2. The City of Roswell has budgeted the required funds for the sidewalk improvements and will pay all Project costs which exceed the funding amount.**
- 3. The City of Roswell has placed this project as a high priority and will meet or exceed all required deadlines.**
