A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL TO APPEAL THE 2010 CENSUS COUNT THROUGH THE COUNT QUESTION RESOLUTION (CQR) PROGRAM UNDER THE BUREAU OF THE CENSUS, COMMERCE UNDER FEDERAL REGISTER/VOL. 76, NO. 45/TUESDAY MARCH 8, 2011/NOTICES, DOCKET NUMBER 110209126-1124-02.

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell desires to appeal the 2010 Census Count through the Count Question Resolution (CQR) Program under the Bureau of the Census, Commerce.

WHEREAS, adopting Resolution #11-14 will allow the City of Roswell to address requests for correction to the 2010 Census Count of housing units and/or group quarters (GQs) and associated population, based on three types of challenges (1) Boundary, (2) Geocoding, and (3) Coverage.


WHEREAS, Mayor Del Journey is the Chief Local Elected Official of the City of Roswell;
