

**RESOLUTION 12-04  
AMENDING RESOLUTION 11-47  
ELECTION RESOLUTION**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, that:**

A. A regular municipal election for the election of municipal officers shall be held on March 6, 2012. Polls will open at 7:00 a.m. and close at 7:00 p.m.

B. At the regular municipal election, persons shall be elected to fill the following elective offices:

- One Councilor from Ward 1 for a four year term.
- One Councilor from Ward 2 for a four year term.
- One Councilor from Ward 3 for a four year term.
- One Councilor from Ward 4 for a four year term.
- One Councilor from Ward 5 for a four year term.
- One Judge for a four year term.

C. The following question shall be submitted at the regular municipal election:

Shall the City of Roswell, New Mexico, impose a one-eighth (1/8th) of one percent (1%) municipal infrastructure gross receipts tax to be dedicated for municipal infrastructure purposes and economic development plans and projects?

D. The following locations are designated as polling places for the conduct of the regular municipal elections and the precincts are consolidated as follows:

D. **ABSENTEE VOTING.** (By Mail) Any qualified elector of the City of Roswell shall obtain his or her application for an absentee ballot, only from the office of the Municipal Clerk. All applications for an absentee ballot must be completed and accepted by the Municipal Clerk prior to 5:00 p.m., March 2, 2012. After 5:00 p.m. on March 2, 2012, all unused absentee ballots will be publicly destroyed by the Municipal Clerk. The Municipal Clerk will accept completed absentee ballots delivered by mail, or in person by the voter casting the absentee ballot, by a member of the voter's immediate family, or by the caregiver to the voter until 7:00 p.m. on March 6, 2012.

Absentee ballots may be marked in person in the office of the Municipal Clerk during regular hours and days of business, beginning on Tuesday, January 31, 2012 and closing at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 2, 2012.

Early voting on paper ballots counted by a M100 electronic vote tabulator will be conducted in the office of the Municipal Clerk during the regular hours and days of business, beginning on Wednesday, February 15, 2012 and closing at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 2, 2012.


E. Persons desiring to register and vote at the regular municipal election must register with the Chaves County Clerk no later than Tuesday, February 7, 2012 at 5:00 p.m., the date on which the County Clerk will close registration books.

**F. All Declarations of Candidacy shall be filed with the Municipal Clerk on Tuesday, January 10, 2012 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.**

G. On election day the casting of votes by qualified municipal electors shall be recorded on paper ballots to be counted by M100 electronic vote tabulators.
