

RESOLUTION NO. 12-45

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT A NEW MEXICO COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION/LOCAL GOVERNMENT DIVISION; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACT AS THE CITY OF ROSWELL'S AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY OF ROSWELL'S PARTICIPATION IN THE CDBG PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the need exists within the City of Roswell for neighborhood improvement projects in several low and moderate income neighborhoods, and the City desires to apply to the Housing and Urban Development's Community Development Block Grant Program to obtain funding for neighborhood improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell has held 4 public hearings for the public input and comment during the 2013 application process; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that there is a significant need to undertake the Chihuahuita streets, curb and gutter, sidewalks, and ADA improvements project on Bland street starting at Hinkle Street by Mesa Middle School going west to Garden Street, to provide adequate services to the community; and

WHEREAS, the City Council determines that the Chihuahuita streets, curb and gutter, sidewalks, and ADA improvements project on Bland Street starting at Hinkle Street by Mesa Middle School going west to Garden Street, meets the requirements of the Community Development Block Grant Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the governing body, the City Council of Roswell, New Mexico:


That the City Council and Mayor are hereby authorized to prepare and submit a Community Development Block Grant Application to the New Mexico Department of Finance and Administration/Local Government Division for Chihuahuita streets, curb and gutter, sidewalks, and ADA improvements project on Bland Street starting at Hinkle Street by Mesa Middle School going west to Garden Street.

That the City Council designates the Mayor as the City of Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the City of Roswell's participation in the New Mexico CDBG Program.

The City of Roswell officials, staff, and the Southeastern New Mexico Development District/Council of Governments are directed to do any and all acts necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution on behalf of the City of Roswell.

That the full application amount be for \$500,000 of grant funds and the City of Roswell is committing \$50,000 from its Capital Improvements Fund as a cash contribution toward the design, engineering, construction, and acquisition activities of the Chihuahuita streets, curb and gutter, sidewalks, and ADA improvements project on Bland Street starting at Hinkle Street by Mesa Middle School going west to Garden Street.
