for a Transportation Alternatives Project**

WHEREAS, the Transportation Alternatives project named in this resolution is an eligible activity under the Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century (MAP 21);

WHEREAS, the "**Spring River Recreation Trail Lighting Project**" is an approved capital improvement project as noted in **Infrastructure Capital Improvement Plan FY 2014-18** and

WHEREAS, the **City of Roswell** has agreed to provide matching funds at a percentage rate of 14.56% of the cost of land acquisition and construction; and

WHEREAS, the **City of Roswell** has agreed to fund all project development, environmental analysis and design costs separate from the cost of land acquisition and construction; and

WHEREAS, the **City of Roswell**] has agreed to fund all on-going maintenance costs for this Transportation Alternatives project after construction; and

WHEREAS, the **City of Roswell** supports this project and desires to receive funding; and

WHEREAS, the **City of Roswell** understands two resolutions must be submitted, one at the time of an Transportation Alternatives project application and another at the time the project is formally under contract with the New Mexico Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, this resolution is at the time of "**application**" for Transportation Alternatives funding;


