

**RESOLUTION NO. 14-39**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL ADOPTING THE "ALL HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN" FOR ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, PURSUANT TO THE DISASTER MINIMIZATION ACT OF 2000 FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONTINUING ELIGIBILITY TO RECEIVE FEDERAL ASSISTANCE FROM THE ROBERT T. STAFFORD DISASTER RELIEF AND EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE ACT (HAZARDS MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM, PRE-DISASTER MITIGATION PROGRAM, AND FLOOD MITIGATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM).**

**WHEREAS**, the Chaves County All Hazards Mitigation Plan Community Planning Team, comprised of members representing Chaves County, the City of Roswell, the Town of Dexter, the Town of Hagerman, and the Town of Lake Arthur and various other Federal, State, and private agencies, has prepared an All Hazards Mitigation Plan identifying the natural hazards faced by the City of Roswell and participating communities: and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), effective November 1, 2004, a mitigation plan needs to be approved by FEMA and the State of New Mexico for any community that wishes to obtain funding from the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act (Hazards Mitigation Grant Program, Pre-Disaster Mitigation Program, and Flood Mitigation Assistance Program) to reduce potential damages; and

**WHEREAS**, the All Hazards Mitigation Plan has identified a comprehensive range of mitigation action that address the following hazards: floods, high winds, drought, winter storms, thunderstorms, hail, tornados, wildfire, subsidence, West Nile Virus, dam failure and expansive clay soils.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Governing Body, the City Council, for the City of Roswell hereby adopts the Chaves County All Hazards Mitigation Plan.
