

RESOLUTION 14-54

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF OF THE CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT IN TAKING OVER PROPERTY LISTED UNDER THE CITY OF ROSWELL BUILDING AND LANDS TO EXPAND RANDY WILLIS PARK WHICH WOULD BENEFIT THE QUALITY OF LIFE FOR THE CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell Parks and Recreation Department is taking over the parcel of land next to the Randy Willis Park located at 2150 South Sunset Avenue from Building and Lands; and

WHEREAS, the Parcel of Land involved has the coordinates of South 820' of the West 1300' of the NE V4 of the NE V4 of Section 18, Township 11 South Range 24 East adjacent to the north of Randy Willis Park; and

WHEREAS, the transfer of this parcel will be added to the existing park land which will increase the possibility of developing additional fields, trails and open space thus enhancing the quality of life for the citizens; and

WHEREAS, the expansion to Randy Willis Park will potentially provide added recreation and sports programs for the children of the City, and will provide opportunities that encourage children to pursue healthy, creative activities and avoid involvement in crime; and


WHEREAS, the expansion of Randy Willis Park will offer the primary user of the property, who is the Lions Hondo Little League, to put in additional fields and parking that will further develop the park to benefit the youth in the community; and

WHEREAS, the further development of the park will be the responsibility of the primary user which will benefit that organization and will also be shared and made available for all citizens in the community to use under the guidance and direction of the the City of Roswell Parks and Recreation Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Governing Body, the City Council, for the City of Roswell hereby adopts the Resolution 14-54 in Support of the Parks and Recreation Department taking over property listed under Buildings and Lands to expand Randy Willis Park for the Benefit of the Citizens of the City of Roswell.
