A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SUBMIT THE 2018-2022, FIVE YEAR INFRASTRUCTURE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PLAN (I.C.I.P.) WITH THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO, DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION, L.G.D. ADOPTING RESOLUTION #16-51 WILL ALLOW FOR POSSIBLE FUNDING OF CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECTS BY THE STATE LEGISLATURE ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell desires to submit the 2018-2022, five year, Infrastructure Capital Improvements Plan (I.C.I.P.) including priority projects for fiscal year 2018 to the State of New Mexico, Department of Finance and Administration, L.G.D., and

- Air Center Roof Replacements
- Road Reconstruction and ADA Upgrades
- Senior Center Roof Replacement
- 105 Foot Aerial Ladder Truck
- Cemetery Street Repaving

WHEREAS, Mayor Dennis Kintigh is the Chief Local Elected Official of the City of Roswell;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the governing body, the City Council of Roswell, New Mexico: that the Mayor is hereby authorized to submit the 2018-2022, five year Infrastructure Capital Improvements Plan on behalf of the City of Roswell, and to perform any and all such other acts, matters and manner of things as shall be and become necessary and proper to effectuate the purposes herein.


