

RESOLUTION NO. 1633

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT WITH THE NEW MEXICO STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT FOR ATKINSON AVENUE IMPROVEMENTS FROM COLLEGE TO FIFTH STREET, AT AN ESTIMATED COST OF \$384,014.

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell has heretofore petitioned the New Mexico State Highway Department, acting through its Highway Commission, to participate in improvements to Atkinson Avenue within the City of Roswell; and,

WHEREAS, the improvements contemplated are estimated to cost \$384,014, and will involve street drainage into the Hondo River and Spring River, paving, curb and gutter, and sidewalks from Fifth Street and College Boulevard; and,

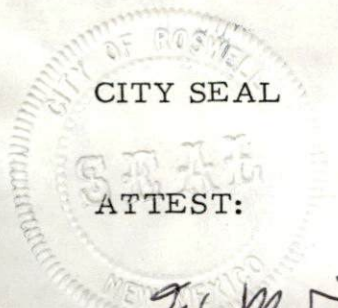
WHEREAS, a Cooperative Agreement on a 50-50 basis is to be entered into between the City of Roswell and the New Mexico State Highway Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

1. That any and all acts, matters and manner of things heretofore had, made and done in the matter of the Cooperative Agreement be, and the same hereby are approved, ratified and confirmed for all intents and purposes.

2. That the Mayor and City Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver said Cooperative Agreement and to do and perform all such other acts, matters and manner of things as shall be and become necessary and proper to effectuate the same.

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
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
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
