WHEREAS, the expansion of national uranium resources capacity is a viable contributing factor in resolving the energy crunch, insofar as it relates to diminished interdependence upon foreign petroleum imports, and


WHEREAS, the expedient location of nuclear producing installations within strategic areas can spark regional development and contribute to stabilization of the local economy.

WHEREAS, native geographic and economic attributes of the expanding Pecos Valley area are conducive to such development and, the municipal governing body is presently unaware of any cogent community opposition therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

1. That the Mayor of the City of Roswell be, and he hereby is authorized and empowered to lend all bona-fide effort of municipal agencies and instrumentalities in the direction of locating nuclear installation or installations within the Pecos Valley area, and to do and perform all such other acts, matters and manner of things as shall be and become necessary and proper to establish favorable on-site locations.


